Trouble is, it can be hard to find an affordable place to stay. Here's one that opened in January: The [Sofia Hotel](#). Yup, that's it, but you'd never know it. The owners spent \$16 mil spiffing it up into a cool spot with contemporary rooms with top linens and a new spa and 24-hour yoga studio. Best of all, rooms start at \$149 a night, and there are pet-friendly packages. Check it out.
